INTRODUCTION

The International Widows Association for South Sudanese Refugees in Uganda (IWASSRU) is a charitable association working with destitute widows and orphans in Sudanese refugee camps in northern Uganda and in the SPLAM controlled areas of Kajo-keji south Sudan. It provides parental care, education and medical care to the vulnerable orphans whose parents fell victims of the 21-year conflict in the Sudan. IWASSRU also supports widows in counseling and in activities that are income generating to enable them reduce on challenges of poverty in their home areas. Amazing Grace Orphanage was established in 1994 and St. Bartholomew was established in 2003 as home for the homeless Sudanese children in Adjumani-Uganda and Kajo-keji-south Sudan respectively.

AIM/GOAL

To improve on secretarial services of the association.
